Sharon Taberski

Sharon Taberski is a nationally recognized educator, author, and presenter. A teacher for 28 years, Sharon currently works in school districts throughout the country helping teachers set up reading and writing workshops, and think systematically about how to best accomplish their goals.

In her latest work, *Comprehension from the Ground Up*, Sharon cuts through the pressurized, strategy-overloaded, fluency-crazed atmosphere surrounding reading instruction to lay out reading and workshop practices that are most effective in the primary grades. Sharon is also the author of *It's ALL About Comprehension, Teaching K-3 Readers from the Ground Up*, that shows how to teach children through rich, varied, comprehension-building experiences through the literacy block. Sharon is also the author of *On Solid Ground: Strategies for Teaching Reading K-3*, and the video series *A Close-Up Look at Teaching Reading: Focusing on Children and Our Goals*.
