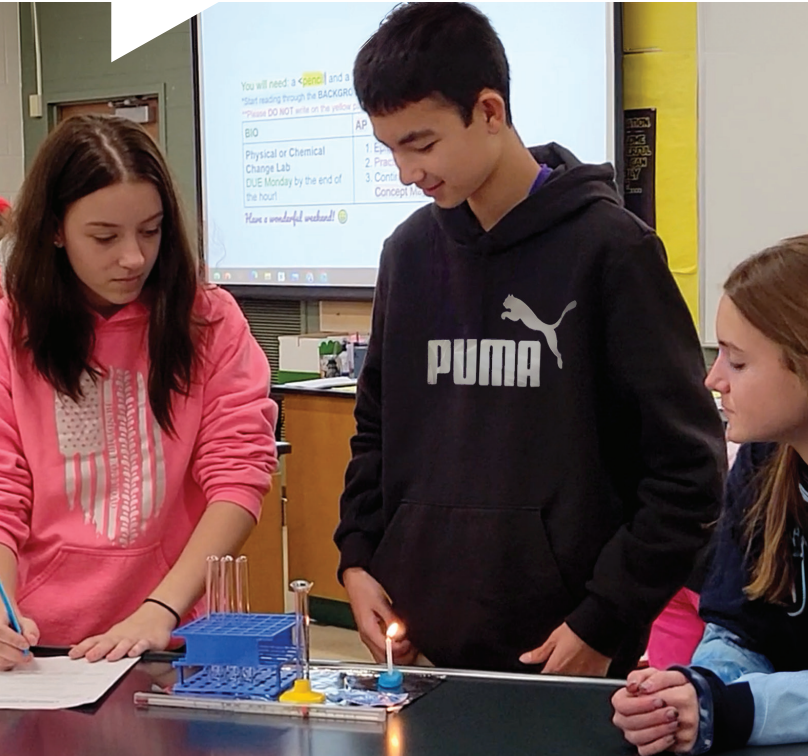


# MCMC BELONGS TO YOU
