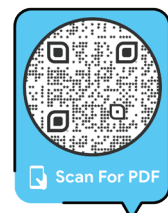

A Michigan baby dies every 2-3 days due to sleep-related causes. Following the safe sleep steps can help prevent these types of deaths.



SAFE SLEEP STEPS*

- ✓ **Sleep on Back:** Place baby on the back to sleep.
- ✓ **In Own Sleep Space:** Place baby in a crib, bassinet or pack and play with a firm mattress and a tightly fitted sheet. Baby's sleep surface should be flat.
- ✓ **Remove Clutter:** Keep baby's sleep space clutter free—no pillows, blankets or toys.
- ✓ **Breastfeed:** Feed your baby human milk, if you can.
- ✓ **Room Share:** Keep baby's sleep space near your bed—share your room, not your bed.
- ✓ **Avoid Overheating:** Make sure baby doesn't get too warm. If you think baby is cold, use a sleep sack or wearable blanket.
- ✓ **No Smoking:** Keep baby's environment smoke and nicotine-free.
- ✓ **Reminders:** Remind everyone who cares for your baby how to keep baby safe while sleeping.

BIRTH THROUGH AGE 5

BUILD UP MICHIGAN

- MCISD provides a free educational evaluation and education services to children who have physical, social, emotional, or learning conditions that prevent them from succeeding in school
- MCISD works to meet students' needs so they can receive the best education possible



EARLY HEAD START



- Federally funded tuition FREE home visiting program for expectant moms and/or children 0-3 years old
- Socialization opportunities are offered
- Weekly home visits are required
- Transportation to and from necessary appointments
- Eligibility requirements apply

EARLY ON PROGRAM

- Provides early intervention services for infants and toddlers, birth to three years of age, with developmental delays and/or disabilities
- Supports families as their children learn and grow by providing parent education, developmental screening and tracking, and other educational support services.
- Services are provided in the home or in community-based settings



HEAD START



- Federally funded tuition preschool program for 3-5 year old children
- Free for families that meet eligibility requirements
- Center-based preschool program offering 7.25 hours/day, Monday-Thursday
- Breakfast, Lunch and Snack provided daily
- 16 Classrooms are in various locations throughout Monroe County
- Limited transportation is offered at Riverside Early Learning Center

GREAT START READINESS PROGRAM (GSRP)



- Michigan's nationally recognized preschool program for children turning 4 by December 1
- Free for families that meet eligibility requirements
- High-quality preschool instruction focuses on early literacy, math and social emotional development
- Full, school day schedules operating Monday-Thursday
- Extended-year, 5 days per week available at several locations
- Transportation available at most locations
- Before and after-care programs available at several locations, at an additional cost
- Meals and snacks served daily
- Available in local school district, charters, and several community childcare locations

PARENT/CHILD INTERACTION GROUPS



- The purpose is to encourage parent/child activities such as reading and literacy, rhymes and songs, music and movement, art and opportunities for social development
- All Parent/Child Interaction Groups are free and hosted at various locations around Monroe County
- There are opportunities for children from birth to age five to attend

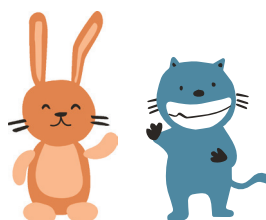
